The Caddy Club was called to order by Mr. Speed at 6:40pm on Thursday, May 8, 2008.

Mr. Speed stated the purpose of the meeting, to continue to plan the golf tournament. He then asked for the review and approval of the previous meeting's minutes. The minutes were approved, with a motion by Jan-Paul Kusters and a second by Kevin Voss.

The meeting's focus revolved around further planning of the golf tournament:

- Worldlink's contribution of \$1,200 will form one team with Sarosh and three community employees (firemen / policemen) and one additional hole sponsor; the remainder will be a donation to the club.
- Hutton Communication's contribution of \$1,000 will pay for two teams (community employees) and an additional hole sponsor; the remainder will be a donation to the club.
- The team count is looking good, we are at 28 and more are coming in.
- A change to the ball drop organization. This will be going through Sue Speed. She has all the forms numbered and has been assigning those out to the golf team to sell and to parents as they call in. Please continue to work with Sue. Peter will manage the golf ball drop on the day of the event.
- Hole sponsor count is at 14, we would still like to reach 18 or more.
- Advantage Golf will print and prepare the hole signs at a cost \$26 per sign. They do a really good job with a very nice background of blue sky and golf course. The hole signs will read: "Centennial Titan's Golf Team" and the sponsors logo.
- The next focus was to ensure we had plenty of parents to work the volunteer needs the day of the tournament. Leann volunteered to work the ball drop table along with Ann Whitecotton.
- Jan-Paul volunteered to stuff all the bags with the help of the Varsity team one afternoon next week after school. He will be responsible for bringing these to the tournament.
- We will also sell 2 Mulligans per person, at \$5.00 each, the day of the event.
- Prizes for the tournament will be the gift cards we've purchased from PGA Tour Superstore (Terri Green will pick these up on Friday 5/9). Exact prizes will be determined next week, but we are thinking a 1st and 2nd prize overall along with prizes by flight. The remaining gift cards will be used in the silent auction.
- We are also planning on a longest drive contest as well; however, we have not purchased the insurance for the typical "hole-in-one" contest.
- Diane Smith is to send the silent auction item list to Ken for him to draw up a flyer for distribution to the neighborhoods in order to publicize the event.

Other business:

- Coach Sadler reported the outcome of the State Tournament: John Darden placed 3rd and Krisha shot very well with being just a Freshman. Several FISH employees attended the tournament, including Dr. Reedy and Mr. Spain.
- Coach Sadler made the request for the club to pay for a coach's clinic this summer at UT, the topic is the "Mental Game". She is attending two other clinics as well that will come from her athletic budget and she's made the request for the club to pay for the additional clinic. A motion was made by Kevin Voss and a 2nd received by Ken Doherty. All approved.
- The last topic for the evening is the end-of-year banquet. The banquet will be held at Coach Joe's on Preston, buffet style in the back room. Terri Green is finalizing the costs and will let Diane know. Once we receive this, an email will go out to the parents informing them of the date and time.
- This will be our last meeting for this school year. We will conduct a short business meeting the night of the banquet to receive the final income and expense numbers for the golf tournament. If this is not possible, we will perform by email or conference call with the officers of the club.

With no other business to discuss, Coach Sadler will inform the team when try-outs are for next year. Have a good summer!
